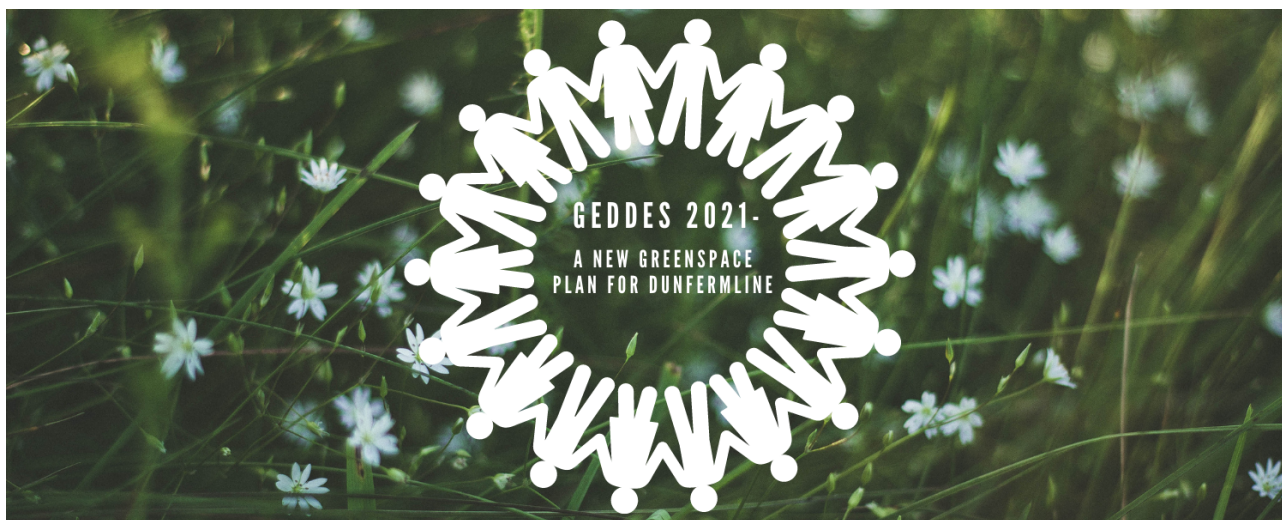

Workshop 1. Social Prescribing: RSPB Nature Prescriptions

Laura Copley, RSPB Scotland Education, Youth & Families Manager and Helen Moncrieff, RSPB Shetland Islands Manager

RSPB's Nature Prescriptions is inspired by growing evidence that connecting with nature makes us healthier and happier. The initiative started in Shetland in 2017 as a partnership between RSPB Scotland and NHS Shetland, and was successfully rolled out to all 10 practices across Shetland in 2018. A new Edinburgh pilot aims to investigate whether Nature Prescriptions can be delivered in a similar way in an urban environment, and to explore the potential for extending it throughout Scotland.

Workshop 2. 'Place/Work/Folk'

Natalia Palombo and Robyn Wolsey, Deveron Projects

Natalia and Robyn will be talking about Deveron Projects' relationship to Patrick Geddes and the motto of 'Place/Work/Folk' that the organisation has adopted. With this context, they will discuss the organisation's experience of building regeneration strategies (Room to Thrive) from the ground up through creative and cultural projects.

Workshop 3. Modern Urban Planning

Paul Morsley, Iglu Studio

"Geddes said 'This is a green world, with animals comparatively few and small, and dependent on the leaves. By leaves we live'."

The everyday reality is that in modern urban planning landscape and placemaking, 'leaves by which we live', are often afforded token importance. Is this view correct and if so, how can we change this paradigm and deliver real urban landscapes that are accessible by, and of benefit to all for generations to come?

Workshop 4. Empowering Communities - The Power of Cooperation, Europe

Simon Glinvad Nielsen is a founder and urban entrepreneur with a focus on reinventing the structures that make towns and cities come alive. He works on an international level, advising and inspiring governments, municipalities, the European Parliament, the European Commission, ministers, mayors, major banks, developers, NGOs, and key stakeholders in private businesses.

In his workshop Simon will talk about The Power of Cooperation and share the story of the Swedish town of Västervik. He will also introduce and discuss his mini book "A Living Dunfermline".
